Oncology Second Opinion Service Expands Beyond First Year Pilot, Adds World-Renowned Physician to Roster

Cincinnati Cancer Advisors Welcomes Dr. Abdul Rahman Jazieh to Expert Team

CINCINNATI – March 31, 2021 – Cincinnati Cancer Advisors (CCA), the city's premier oncology second opinion service, has added an internationally acclaimed physician, Dr. Abdul Rahman Jazieh, M.D., MPH, to its team of experts. Founded as a pilot program in 2020, CCA has expanded rapidly via word of mouth for its expert second opinion review, having served more than 270 patients since the beginning of 2020 despite the COVID-19 pandemic.

Most notably, in an effort to raise the level of cancer care in Cincinnati, CCA's second opinion service is available to members of the Greater Cincinnati community free of charge thanks to the Cincinnati Cancer Foundation and its 20/20 Foresight initiative, as well as its many generous donors.

Dr. Abdul Rahman Jazieh, M.D., MPH is a member of the American Board of Oncology, has been an Advisor on Oncology Quality Care and Patient Safety at UC Cancer Institute since September 2017, the Editor-in-Chief of the Global Journal on Quality and Safety in Healthcare since November 2017, and is currently the Chairman of the International Affairs Committee of the American Society of Clinical Oncology.

"I am excited to return to Cincinnati to work with a team that is solely focused on reducing the suffering and mortality that is normally associated with a cancer diagnosis," said Dr. Jazieh. "The Cincinnati Cancer Advisors approach involves working collaboratively with the patient's physician to help improve the patient's outcome through comprehensive secondary case reviews. Contributions from our generous donors mean that we can offer these services free of charge to Greater Cincinnati cancer patients. This is very unique, if not unprecedented in the oncology space."
